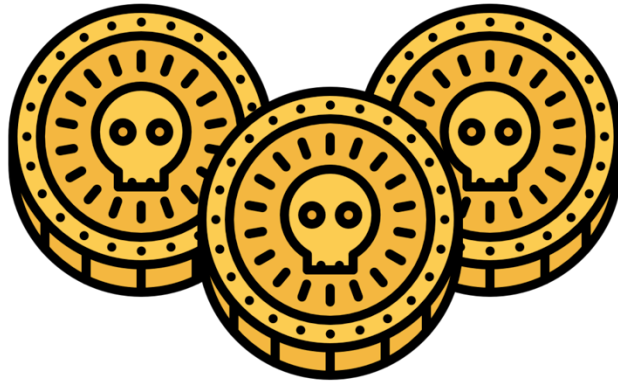
READY FOR A CHALLENGE?
