Double-Symbols

Pizza=37

A double-symbol is a grouping that can be interpreted as follows:

$$\text{🍕🍕} = \left(\text{🍕} + \text{🍕} \right)$$

or

$$\text{🍕🍕} = \left(\text{🍕} \times 2 \right)$$
