Fun Fact: Chocolate chips were invented in 1937 by Ruth Graves Wakefield, the owner of the Toll House Inn in Massachusetts, who chopped up a bar of semi-sweet chocolate and added the chunks to her cookie dough, creating the world's first chocolate chip cookie. This accidental invention quickly became a sensation, leading to the mass production of chocolate chips as we know them today.
