Fun Fact: Europe Day is actually celebrated on two different dates, reflecting the dual nature of the European Union and the Council of Europe. The European Union celebrates Europe Day on May 9th, in honor of the Schuman Declaration of 1950, which proposed the creation of a European Coal and Steel Community, the precursor to the EU. Meanwhile, the Council of Europe, an entirely separate organization, celebrates Europe Day on May 5th, the date of its founding in 1949. These two celebrations reflect the complex and rich history of European integration and cooperation.
