Persevering through difficult practice develops grit and teaches you to never give up!



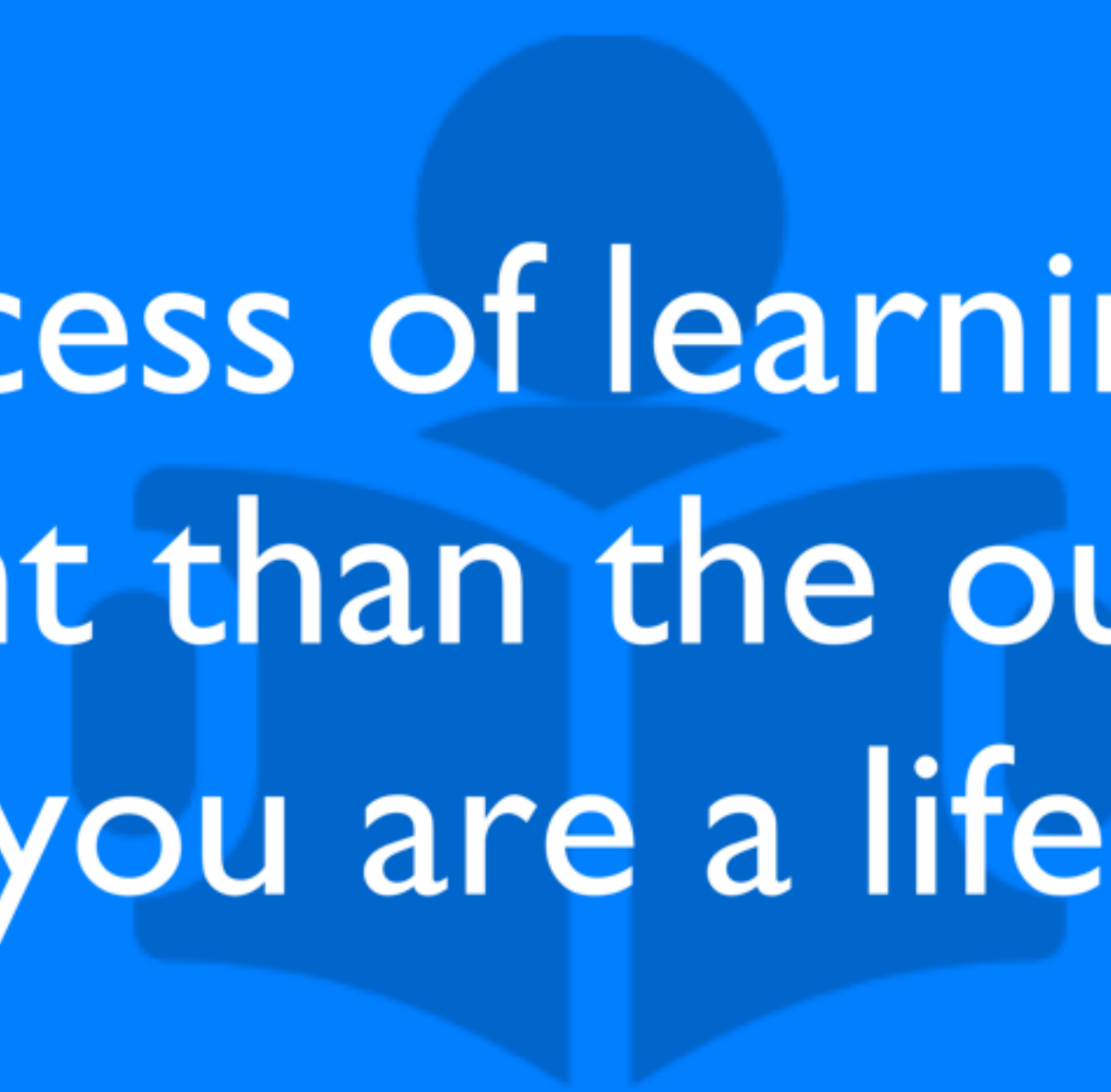
Making a mistake is no big deal because mistakes are opportunities to learn and grow!



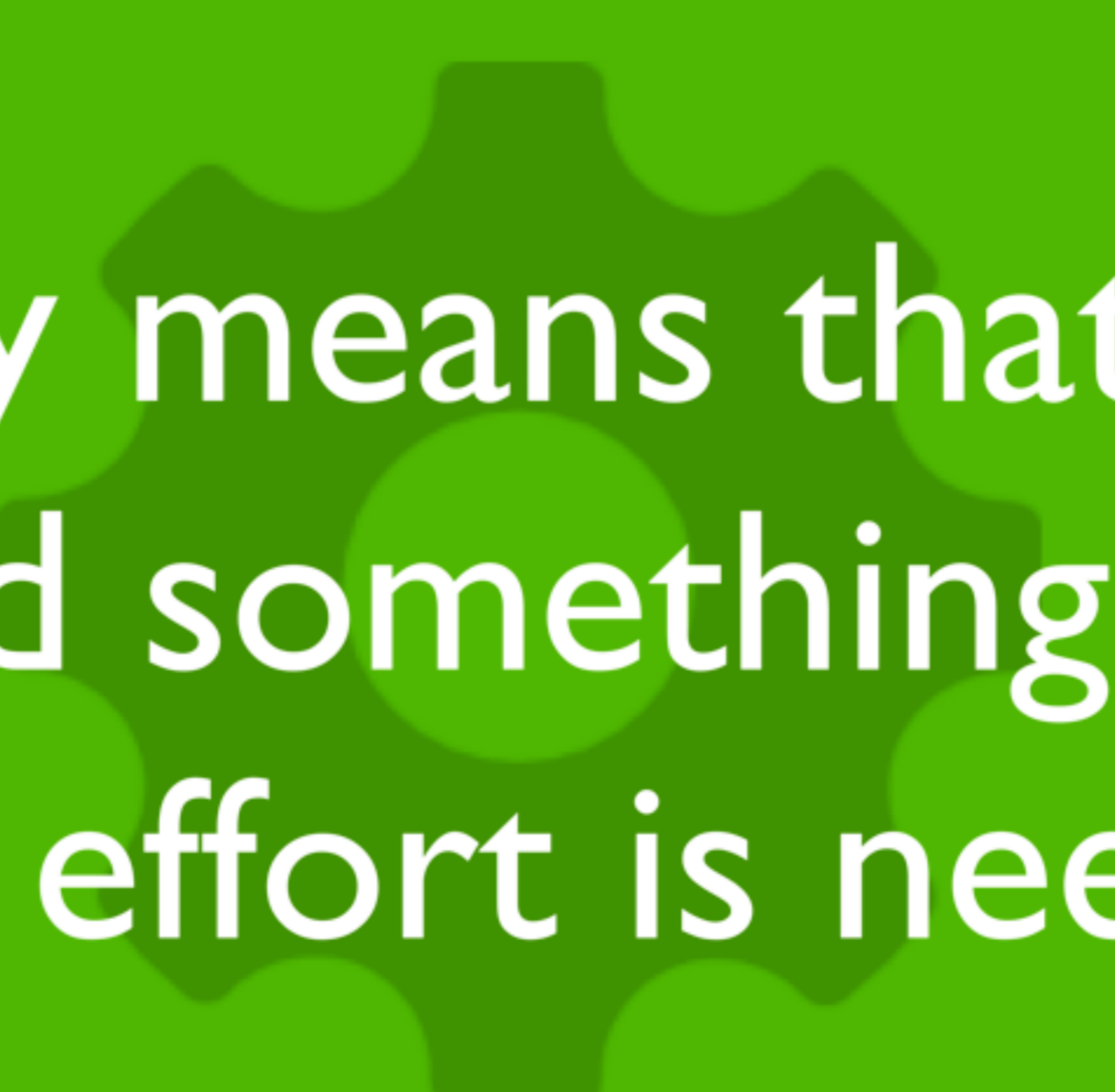
Asking for help is never something to be afraid of!



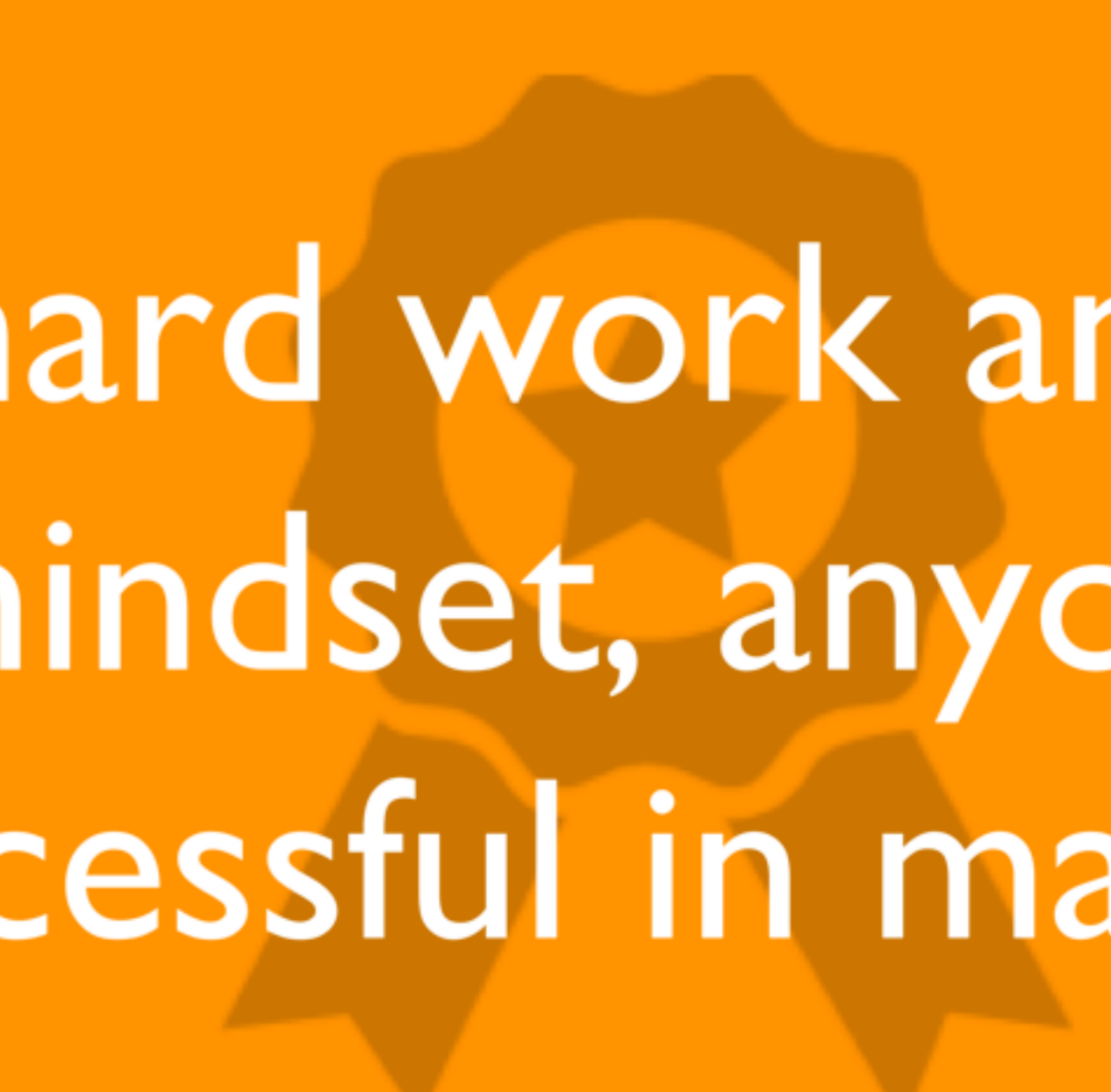
The process of learning is more important than the outcome because you are a lifelong learner!
