He was condemned to wander the Earth, lighting his way with a coal inside a hollowed-out turnip. Irish immigrants brought this tradition to America, where pumpkins, being native and more abundant in the fall, were used instead of turnips, giving rise to the jack-o'-lanterns we see today.
