$$\text{Bowl of Linguine} + \text{Bowl of Linguine} - \text{Fork with Linguine} = \text{Restaurant Building}$$

$$\text{Cheese and Garlic} - \text{Restaurant Building} = 3$$

$$\text{Bowl of Linguine} = \text{Fork with Linguine} + 2 + 2$$

$$46 - \text{Fork with Linguine} = 37$$

**Fun Fact:** The word *Linguine* means "little tongues" in Italian, a nod to its long, flat, and narrow shape. Originating from the Liguria region of Italy, linguine is often paired with lighter, seafood-based sauces, such as clam sauce, or with pesto, reflecting the culinary traditions of the Italian Riviera where seafood and fresh herbs like basil are plentiful.
