## Double-Symbols

A double-symbol is a grouping that can be interpreted as follows:

Pancake Stack=40

Syrup=100

Frying Pan=4

Mixing Bowl=25

**?=260**

$$\text{🥞🥞} = \left( \text{🥞} + \text{🥞} \right)$$

or

$$\text{🥞🥞} = \left( \text{🥞} \times 2 \right)$$
