

Fun Fact: Pineapples are not a single fruit, but a cluster of up to 200 fruitlets fused together. Originating from South America, pineapples are actually a type of bromeliad and the only bromeliad out of about 3,000 species to produce a commercially important fruit. Each fruitlet can be identified by an "eye," the rough, spiny marks on the pineapple's surface. This unique structure makes the pineapple a fascinating example of a composite fruit in the plant world.
