

Fun Fact: The exact beginning of this holy month varies each year and from one country to another, as it depends on the sighting of the moon, following the Islamic lunar calendar. This lunar basis makes the month of Ramadan move approximately 11 days earlier each year in the Gregorian calendar, leading to a cycle that sees Ramadan occurring in different seasons over a 33-year period.
