Fun Fact: The color originally associated with St. Patrick was blue, not green. Green became linked with St. Patrick's Day during the 18th century, when green ribbons and shamrocks were worn in celebration. The shift to green was also influenced by Ireland's nickname, "The Emerald Isle," the green in the Irish flag, and the clover that St. Patrick used in his teachings about Catholicism. Today, green is synonymous with the holiday, seen in everything from clothing to rivers dyed green in cities across the world.
