

As a show of appreciation, families would offer teachers sustenance, including baskets of apples, which were considered a luxury. This gesture of gratitude evolved over time, particularly in the United States during the 19th and 20th centuries, into the symbolic act of giving an apple to the teacher, representing a student's appreciation and respect.
