Directions: Use your math skills to find the value of each icon and the '?' in the puzzle below.

$$\text{Waffle with fruit} \times \text{Waffle with fruit} + \text{Syrup} = 100$$

$$\text{Butter} = \text{Syrup} \div \text{Butter}$$

$$\text{Waffle with fruit} + 34 + \text{Waffle with fruit} = 50$$

$$\text{Butter} = \text{Strawberry} + \text{Strawberry}$$

$$\text{Waffle with fruit} + \text{Strawberry} \times \text{Syrup} + \text{Butter} = ?$$
